Virtual Intercultural Leadership Program Information

All North Star Youth Exchange applicants are invited to participate in one of two week-long Virtual Intercultural Leadership Programs.

- Program participants will develop leadership skills, cultural competence, reflective personal growth, and a commitment to servant leadership through community action.
- Students will learn and practice active listening, giving and receiving feedback, creating inclusive spaces, and cross-cultural communication.
- The camp will provide participants with enhanced leadership skills with an international focus as it will include participants from around the world as well as from the North Star region.
- Partial scholarships available on a need basis for North Star participants (Districts 5050 and 5960)

Program dates:

- July 19-23 – ages 15-16 years old
- July 26-30 – ages 17-18 years old

Program length: 5 consecutive days 10 a.m. to 1 p.m. EDT (with breaks)

Program Outline

- Day 1 - Participant orientation - Community building - Introduction to servant leadership tools: active listening, giving and receiving feedback, debate and dialogue, and creating inclusive spaces
- Day 2 - Participant-led community building activity - Continuation of servant leadership tools: active listening, giving and receiving feedback, debate and dialogue, and creating inclusive spaces
- Day 3 - Participant-led community building activity - Introduction to cross-cultural communication and practice
- Day 4 - Participant-led community building activity - Continuation of cross-cultural communication and practice
- Day 5 - Participant-led community building activity - Coming full circle: taking action in our community for positive change - Introduction to and development of individual servant leadership growth plan
