**Dec. 27 (Sun.)** – Sun Moon Lake cycling tour, camp orientation, ice-breaking activities, and ocarina lesson.

**Dec. 28 (Mon.)** – Visit a honeybee farm and tea culture center; welcome evening with indigenous performance and campfire activities.

**Dec. 29 (Tue.)** – Stand-Up Paddling at Sun Moon Lake, traditional paper-making experience, guzheng performance, and ocarina lesson.

**Dec. 30 (Wed.)** – Visit a persimmon farm and release sky lanterns in Pingxi; transfer to Taipei.

**Dec. 31 (Thu.)** – Taipei City Tour & Taipei 101 Fireworks Show. Explore Taipei (Dadaocheng or Yongkang Street), Tamsui, and celebrate New Year's Eve with the spectacular Taipei 101 Fireworks Show.

**Jan. 1, 2027 (Fri.)** – Visit the Presidential Office Building and Liberty Square, then head south to Taichung Fish Market – Ha-Yu Wharf and transfer to host families.

**Jan. 2–3 (Sat.–Sun.)** – Host-family stay and local city experiences.

**Jan. 4 (Mon.)** – Puli cultural tour, Geographic Center Monument, fire-dance performance, and ocarina lesson.

**Jan. 5 (Tue.)** – Visit Wanda Power Plant and Aowanda National Forest Recreation Area; evening ocarina practice.

**Jan. 6 (Wed.)** – Hike Hehuan Mountain East Peak and visit Qingjing Farm.

**Jan. 7 (Thu.)** – National Chi Nan University campus tour, music-and-tea gathering, 18°C Chocolate Factory, ocarina performance, and farewell party.

**Jan. 8 (Fri.)** – Transfer to Taiwan Taoyuan International Airport and departure.
